Spring Arbor University is a faith-based institution with a deep history founded in 1873 and today has approximately 3000 students. It has been on a journey to completely overhaul its enterprise applications over the last three years.

Having previously implemented Oracle Cloud Financials, Customer Experience, and Student Financial Planning, Spring Arbor began working with Sierra-Cedar in March 2023 to implement the Oracle Student Management Cloud application, replacing its legacy student system along with implementing Salesforce for admissions.

Oracle Student Management Cloud (SMC) will enable the transformation of the student experience by streamlining all points of access for student services. Spring Arbor intends to redefine the student experience model as SMC is implemented and processes are redefined. The Spring Arbor digital transformation will build robust processes that allow students to engage within different virtual contexts and empower faculty and administration to deliver exceptional service.

This historic project will be one of the first implementations of Oracle Fusion Cloud Student in the country and will focus on improving the student experience.
