Background

In 2012, Broward determined that it was time to replace its 25-year-old core administrative ERP application systems in order to realize excellence in IT operations and administrative efficiency, free-up resources, and add value to its student-centric mission. To meet its needs, Broward chose Workday HCM/Payroll and Financials and selected Sierra-Cedar as its prime implementation partner.

Challenges

Together, we overcame a number of challenges, including the following:

- Broward was the first Workday client anywhere to implement Workday's brand new Period Activity Pay functionality. The Sierra-Cedar consultants' understanding of how full-time and adjunct faculty are paid was invaluable to this effort.
- Broward users needed a way to visualize the new business processes, so Sierra-Cedar conducted business process redesign sessions to optimize and illustrate best practice process flow.
- Broward's student payment activities outside of Workday were impacting its ability to accurately complete bank reconciliation and accounting processes. Sierra-Cedar created complex integrations to bring Student System financial transactions into Workday.
- Broward was committed to fully leveraging Workday's
 multidimensional accounting model while keeping the proper Chart
 of Financial Authority approval path in place. Sierra-Cedar made
 this possible by implementing two intersection security groups
 between different types of organizations.

Solution

Sierra-Cedar served as Broward's prime deployment partner for Workday HCM, Payroll, and Finance. Roles include Project Management, Integration, Configuration, and Change Management services, complemented by Workday's Delivery Assurance role. As a result of this effort:

- Broward College was the first public higher education institution to go live with Workday HCM and Payroll – October 1, 2013.
- Broward was the first public higher education institution to go live with Workday in 12 months or less.
- HCM went live in October, and Broward conducted its first online
 Open Enrollment (formerly done 100% on paper) in November—a huge win for all.
- Broward is on track to go live with Financials in July 2014.
- Broward's HR processes are now fully transparent to Hiring Managers.
- The community as a whole is enjoying the benefit of having time tracking, time off, and benefits all visible. Processes previously completed on paper have now become easy to complete in Workday.
